## Short Course Global OHS at INJE University, Korea

In August 2023, the Department of Occupational Health and Safety - Faculty of Environment and Labour Safety, organized a two-week short-term Global OHS program at Ton Duc Thang University (Tan Phong campus) for a group of students from INJE University (South Korea). Following the cooperative program between the two units, the Department of Occupational Health and Safety Engineering (INJE University) is planning to launch the Global OHS 2024 course at INJE in January 2024. The course is designed exclusively for students from Southeast Asian countries to participate in direct learning in South Korea.

This is an opportunity for students to have a short-term study abroad experience, improve their specialized English language skills, and meet and exchange with international students from Universitas Indonesia, RMUTT of Thailand, who also participate in this course.

Study period: from **14<sup>th</sup> January - 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2024**

**Cost: 600 USD** including 3 meals a day, accommodation, fieldtrip, car rental, 2 parties (welcome and farewell parties)

**Not include airfare + visa costs**
