(1) In semester = 440 \$USD/month - maximum 80 hours per month (2) Winter and summer holidays = 660 \$USD/month - maximum 120 hours per month Work-study fees need to deduct labor insurance premiums, so the actual amount received will be deducted another 2~5%.

Remarks	NTD\$ 55,921 is about US\$ 2,000. The university's official announcement will determine each semester's tuition fees.	

- You must pay the enrolment fee first, and the CSU will offer 155 \$USD grants per month (1860 \$USD/year). You can apply for tuition fee payment in installments if necessary. There will be up to 4 installments each semester.
- The student is offered free on-campus housing.
- The international graduate student who receives the CENTER Research Scholarship must provide a few hours per week of service work to the laboratory, including researching and analyzing research projects.
- International students are allowed to work part-time in CENTER's laboratories.
